HAUS Floors are harvested from Legal sustainable forests. The floors are engineered with a Hardwood Top Layer of solid timber, known as a lamella. The Lamella is sawn which gives you an exact look and feel of solid timber, the surface can be re-sanded as you would a normal solid floor, however the benefits of an engineered floor far outweigh those of a solid timber floor.

Engineered Boards are now recognised as being much better than the old fashioned method of Solid boards, which are no way as structurally stable as an engineered board. No two boards are the same, as you would expect from a real timber floor.

HAUS Floors use ply-wood as its structure, Plywood is well known for its stability and strength. HAUS will not cup bend or twist. Someday all timber floors will be made this way.

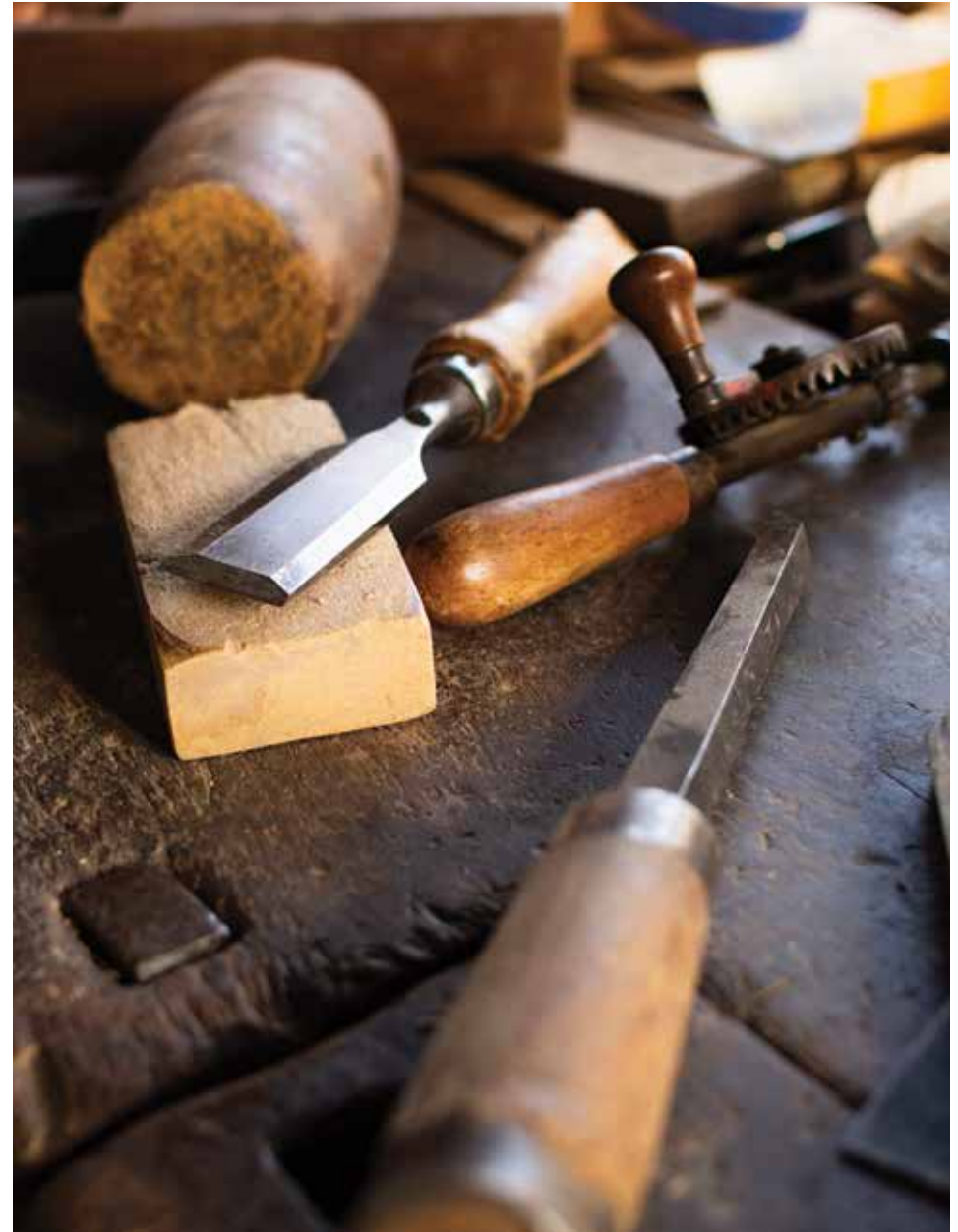

WHY CHOOSE AN ENGINEERED TIMBER FLOOR OVER A TRADITIONAL SOLID TIMBER FLOORS?

- Engineered Hardwood Timber Floors are Real Hardwood Timber Floors
- Engineered Hardwood Timber Floors are far more stable than Solid Timber Floors
- Engineered Hardwood Timber Floors are sustainable, only the top Wear layer is the Important Hardwood Surface Wear Layer
- Engineered Hardwood Timber Floors Structure/Body are made up of cross ply-wood
- Harmony Engineered hardwood Timber floors with a 2mm-6mm wear layer can be re-sanded, just like a solid floor
- Harmony Engineered hardwood Timber floors with a 2mm-6mm wear layer can be re-sanded, just like a solid floor
- Engineered Hardwood Timber Floors can be installed by Glue-Down Method giving a Solid Underfoot feel or they can be Floated
- Engineered Hardwood Timber Floors are far quicker to Install, therefore more cost effective saving thousands of dollars on projects
- Engineered Hardwood Timber Floors do not need as many Expansion Joints as they are far more dimensionally stable
- Harmony Engineered Hardwood Floors installed GlueDown Method can be silicone around the Cabinetry & Skirtings giving a far better overall appearance (this cannot be done with solid floors)
- Harmony Engineered Hardwood Timber Floors have a far better & Harder coating applied under controlled conditions allowing for a Twenty Five Year Warranty on the Surface Wear Layer
- Harmony Engineered Hardwood Timber Floors have a Lifetime Structural Warranty

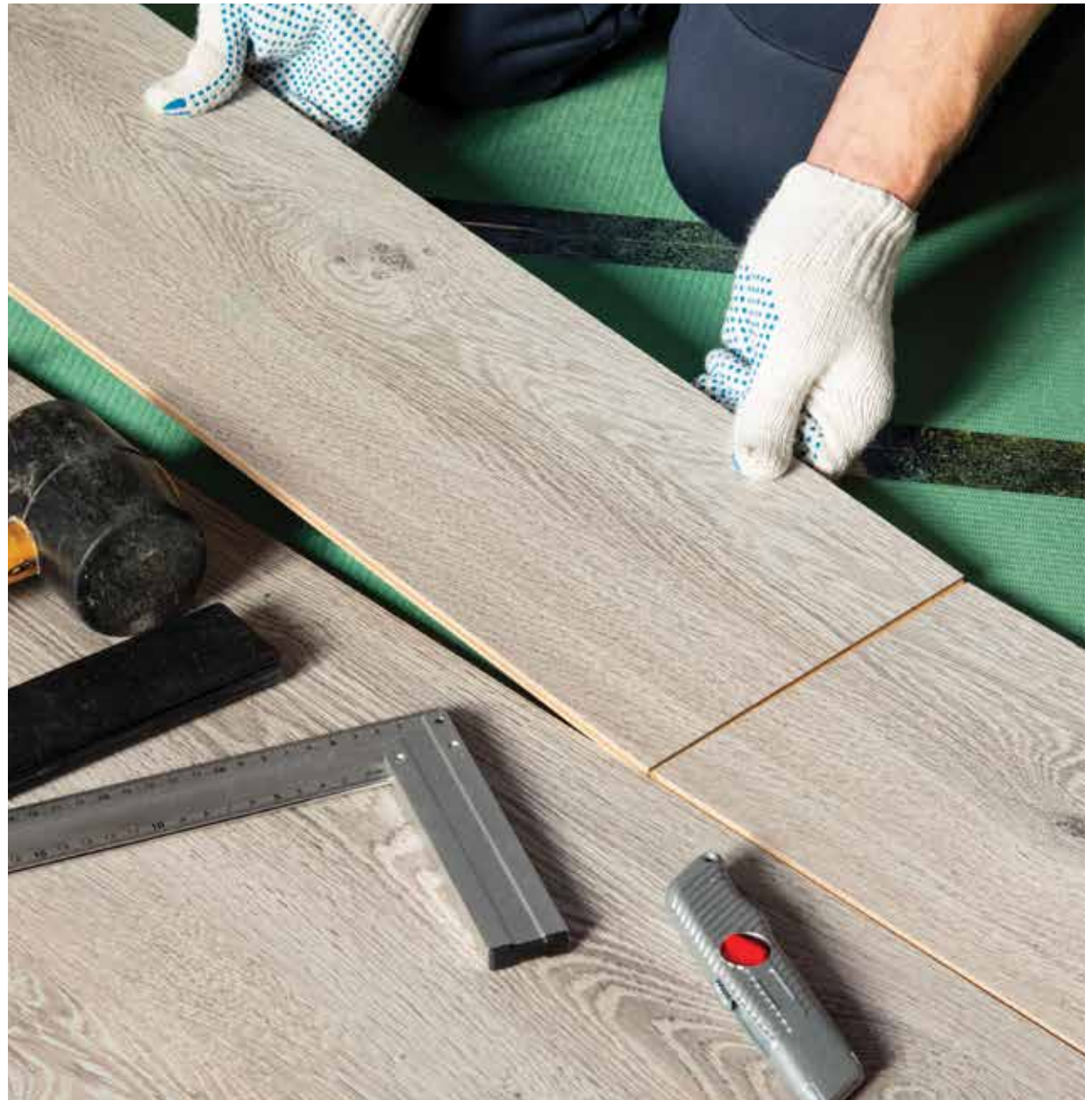

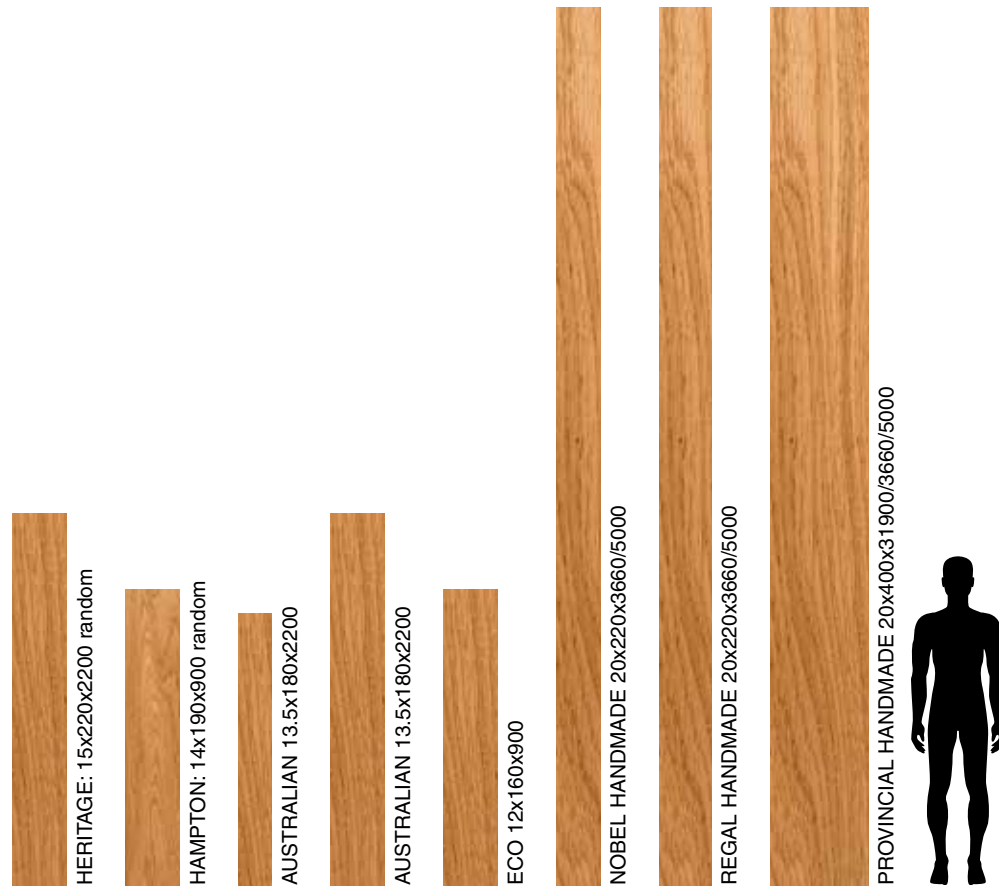

BLACKBUTT

The golden browns and striking pinks of Blackbutt make it a favourite amongst designers and architects alike. The combination of light shades and structural hardness is a unique attribute of this timber and adds to its high demand.

At HAUS Floors we have carefully selected our Blackbutt to highlight the natural characteristics of this species, creating a floor with a modern edge. The timber has a colour ranging from a golden yellow through to pale browns. The colour range is subtle and is excellent where the colour requirement is light and neutral. The sapwood is distinctly lighter than the heartwood. Some material sourced from the northern part of its range may have a slightly pinkish tinge.

Blackbutt continues to be extremely popular with architects and designers for its unique tones and shadings.



SPOTTED GUM

One of the most prized of all Australian timbers spotted gum is a diversely rich timber with a palette that offers a broad spectrum of colours from rich reds and browns through to light charcoal greys producing a floor of striking appeal. A favourite amongst architects and designers, Spotted gum is hard enough to withstand any commercial or residential application and will add uniqueness to any design concept.

General Characteristic The heartwood of spotted gum ranges from a lighter brown to deep red-brown, while the sapwood is generally white. The texture of spotted gum is somewhat greasy to the touch. The species has an interlocked & wavy grain and possesses a fairly coarse texture

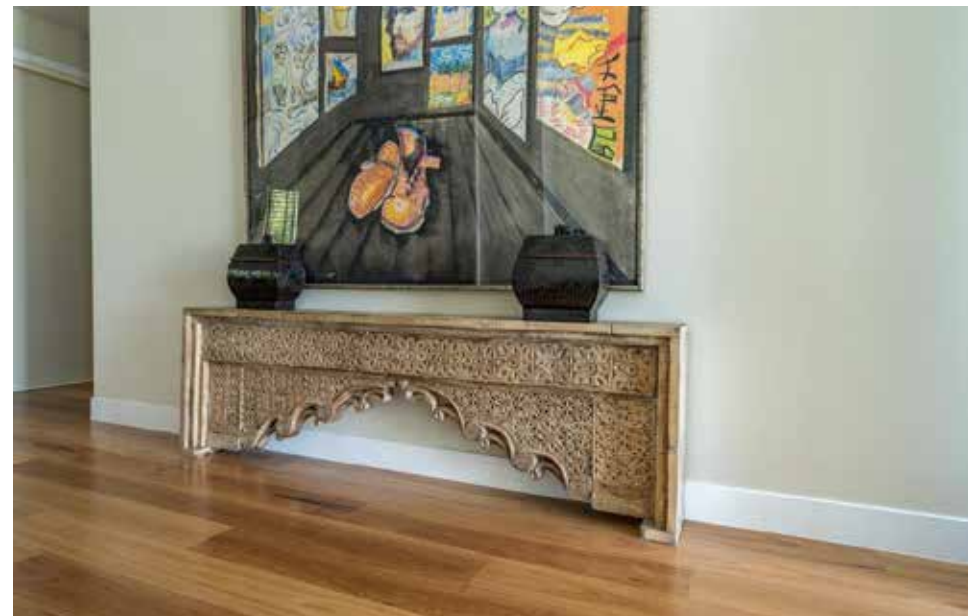


BLUE GUM

Found commonly throughout the east coast of Australia, Blue Gum is a majestically rich timber and is the perfect selection when a more traditional ambience is desired. The dark red hues and heavy browns of this species will deliver a sense of warmth and luxury to any setting and its high durability make it perfect for commercial applications.

Blue Gum's heartwood has a range of colouring from softer brown through deep red hues, while the sapwood has a lighter colouring. This wood has a slightly interlocked or straight grain. It is prized for its strong tones and high lustre.
